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CHAPTER 1

Getting Started

AI Shopping Copilot is a Chrome extension by DABA Enterprise™ that gives you an instant, honest AI verdict on any product before you buy — on Amazon, AliExpress, Shein, eBay, Walmart and 20+ other stores.

Installing the extension

1. Open the Chrome Web Store listing for AI Shopping Copilot.
2. Click "Add to Chrome", then "Add extension" in the confirmation popup.
3. Pin the extension to your toolbar (click the puzzle-piece icon in Chrome, then the pin next to AI Copilot) so it's always one click away.

NO ACCOUNT NEEDED

You can start analysing products immediately — there's no sign-up, no email, and no API key to configure. Just install and go.

Your first analysis

4. Open any product page — for example a listing on amazon.com.au, aliexpress.com, or ebay.com.
5. A slim gold tab labelled AI appears fixed to the right edge of the page.
6. Click the tab to open the panel, then click "Analyse this product".
7. Within a few seconds you'll see a full report: buying score, verdict, price history, review trust, and more.

Where the widget lives

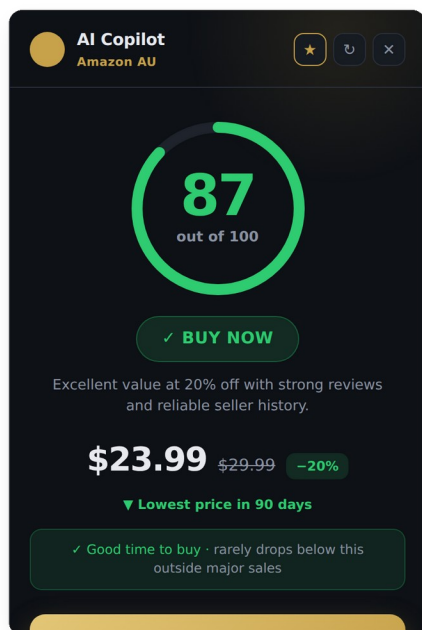
The widget stays anchored to the right edge of every supported product page you visit. Click the gold tab to expand or collapse it — it remembers your product-specific data (like your watchlist status) as you browse.

CHAPTER 2

Reading Your Report

Every full analysis is built around one central idea: a single, honest number and a clear verdict, backed by the details underneath.

The Verdict Ring



The Verdict Ring — your buying score, verdict and price at a glance

The large ring at the top of every report is your Buying Score out of 100, calculated from three factors:

- Value — is the price fair for what you get?
- Quality — what do reviews say about how well it's made or performs?
- Reliability — do buyers report it lasting, or breaking down?

Below the ring, a coloured pill gives you the plain-English verdict:

- Buy Now (green) — strong value, few concerns.
- Wait (amber) — decent, but there's a reason to hold off (often a price signal).
- Skip (red) — meaningful issues outweigh the positives.

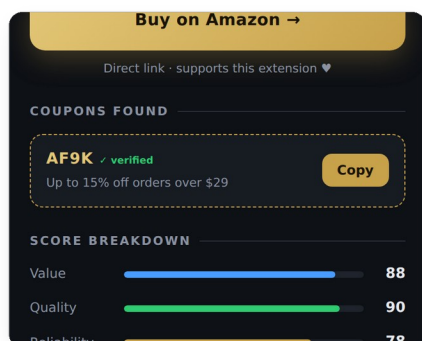
Underneath the verdict, one sentence explains the reasoning in plain language — never just a number with no context.

Price intelligence

Your report shows the current price, the original price if discounted, and a price verdict badge such as “Lowest in 90 days” or “Above average”, so you know if now is actually a good time relative to history.

Where relevant, a timing note tells you whether it's worth waiting — for example, hinting that prices on a category typically drop around major sales.

Coupons



Verified coupon codes surface automatically when available

If a working promo code exists for the store you're on, it appears automatically with a one-tap Copy button — no searching separate coupon sites.

Review Trust



The Review Trust authenticity check flags suspicious review patterns

This is one of the most important sections. The AI examines the review patterns on the page — repetitive phrasing, suspicious bursts of 5-star reviews, incentivised-review disclosures — and gives you an authenticity score. A low score is a genuine warning sign worth taking seriously.

What reviewers say

Reviews are distilled into two clear buckets: what people love, and the recurring issues — including, where visible, roughly what percentage of reviewers mention each issue. This surfaces patterns that are easy to miss when skimming reviews yourself.

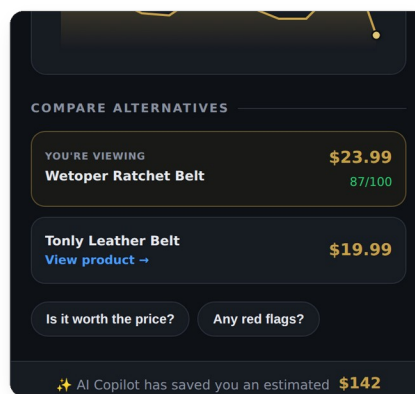
Sentiment & price history



Sentiment breakdown and 12-month price history

The sentiment section breaks overall positivity down by aspect — Quality, Value, Delivery and more — so you can see exactly where a product excels or falls short. The price history chart shows up to 12 months of pricing so you can spot patterns before you buy.

Compare alternatives



Similar products, pulled directly from the page you're viewing

When similar products are available on the same page, the widget lists them with their own price and score so you can compare without opening new tabs. Clicking a similar item takes you straight to that specific product page.

CHAPTER 3

Watchlist & Savings

Watching a product

Tap the star (☆) icon in the widget header to add the current product to your watchlist. It turns solid gold (★) once watched.

- You'll get a browser notification if AI Copilot detects it's worth checking the item again for a price change.
- Tap the star again at any time to stop watching a product.

This is the best way to use AI Copilot for items you're not ready to buy today but want to track.

Your savings tracker

Whenever you buy (or would have bought) a product at a genuine discount that AI Copilot identified, that saving is added to your running total, shown quietly at the bottom of the widget: "AI Copilot has saved you an estimated \$X".

This is a simple, honest way to see the cumulative value the extension is providing over time.

Ask the AI directly

Every report includes a chat box. Use the quick-question chips ("Is it worth the price?", "Any red flags?") for a one-tap answer, or type your own question about the specific product you're viewing — sizing, materials, comparisons, anything the reviews might reveal.

CHAPTER 4

Pro vs Free

AI Shopping Copilot is free to use, with a daily limit on full AI analyses. Pro removes that limit.

Pricing

Upgrade any time from the widget — you'll see an upgrade prompt once you use your 7th full analysis of the day. No commitment; cancel any time.

CHAPTER 5

Tips & Troubleshooting

Getting the most out of it

- Check Review Trust before checking the buying score — a low trust score means the whole review set (and therefore the score) is less reliable.
- Use the price advice note before buying anything non-urgent — many categories have predictable sale cycles.
- Watch items you're on the fence about instead of re-checking manually — let the extension do the tracking.
- Ask the chat a specific question (“does this run small?”) rather than a general one — you'll get a more useful answer.

Troubleshooting

The widget doesn't appear

Confirm you're on a supported store and a specific product page (not a search results or category page). Refresh the page if you navigated there via a link inside the same site.

"Server is waking up" message

This is expected on the first analysis after a period of inactivity — our servers briefly go to sleep to save resources. Wait a few seconds and tap Retry; subsequent analyses will be fast.

"No product detected"

The page you're on doesn't look like a product listing to the extension. This can happen on unusual page layouts. Try refreshing, or let us know which page it was.

A price or review looks wrong

Retailer websites occasionally change their page layout, which can briefly affect extraction accuracy on that specific site. Tap the refresh icon (↻) to re-analyse; if it persists, this helps us know a site needs attention.
